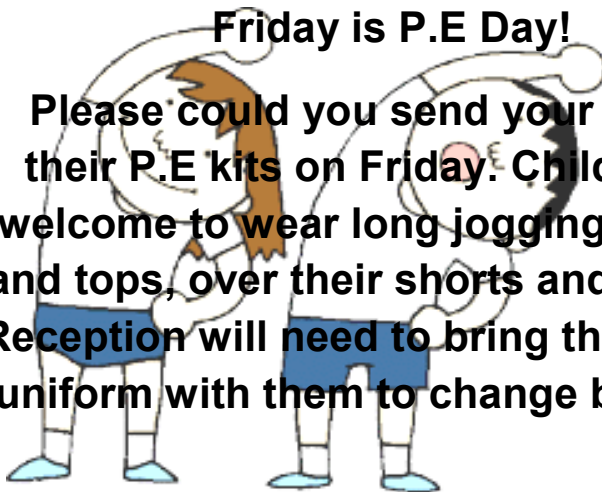
Mrs Farnhill
