Actions

"You said..."

The school does not provide good access to computers and the Internet.

Our response:

- Pupils in KS1 and KS2 have a class bank of Ipads, enough for 1 between 2. These Ipads are used to access the breadth and depth of the computing curriculum, including research work using the internet. We have a high quality range of apps on each I pad that support the curriculum. In addition to this, we have laptops in the learning zone which the children access and use effectively.
- We are buying more Ipads for each class and are purchasing age appropriate tablets for the EYFS children.
- Please be assured that the quality of the computing curriculum is not compromised due to not having a computing suite.

"You said..."

My child is not given challenging work in all classes.

Our response:

- This will be used as a discussion point for staff and governors and we will take your views into account when looking at achievement and progress of the pupils.
- We will also carry out pupil voice to gain the children's perception of this.

"You said..."

My child does not receive appropriate homework for their age.

Our response:

- Our homework policy has been recently reviewed by staff, pupils and governors and this can be found on the school website, was recently emailed out to you and a copy is available from the school office. The quality and appropriateness of homework is monitored by leadership and intervention is taken where needed. If you do not feel that the homework is appropriate then a discussion with the class teacher is useful as this can easily be modified to meet your child's needs.
- We are aware that parents (particularly of upper KS2 pupils) feel that the volume of homework their children receive does not necessarily ensure that they are ready for the large increase in volume of homework they then receive at secondary school. We do increase the amount of homework for Y6 pupils after Christmas and we will consider the options for Year 5 pupils too.

“You said...”

My child is bullied or harassed at school.

Our response:

- This response from 4 parents is a great concern for staff and governors at school. We have an effective behaviour and anti-bullying policy; the pupils are consistently educated in staying safe and treating others with respect and we would like to think that we are able to work with pupils and parents on this issue, if we are aware of the problem.
- May I strongly suggest that if you feel your child is being bullied or harassed at school that an immediate appointment is made to see the class teacher. If the outcomes are not to your satisfaction, then a swift follow up meeting will be arranged with the headteacher.
- In the mean time we will continue to educate our children on this crucial area and will be extra vigilant to any misconduct.

“You said...”

This school does not offer good extracurricular sports provision.

Our response:

- This is an area we are working on. While we endeavour to enter as many sporting competitions as practically possible, as well as having a sporting club each day on the field during lunch (multi-skills, cross country, sports with Mr Clarke, all of which children choose to attend) we acknowledge that we do not hold after school sport clubs. Currently, this is not something that staff can provide as our focus is on teaching and learning and staff workload is already very heavy.
- This could be something that we could look into for external sports providers to do after school, which may incur a small cost to parents if there were more than one club a week.

Thank you for your views on our school and may we reiterate that they are really valuable to us as staff and governors.. It is really important in helping us embed the areas that are working well and further develop those that need it.
