The Quality of Education

Implementation

To ensure assessment for foundation subjects enables pupils to embed and use knowledge fluently and develop their understanding.

Develop pupils understanding of a range of vocabulary to improve outcomes in reading and writing.

Improve teaching and learning of inference in reading across KS1 and KS2.

Focus on reading for pleasure and ensuring the learning environments promote this.

Ensure that pupil's written work is a result of a progressive build up and the right balance of editing to enable depth of content across the curriculum.

To ensure **all** staff are providing purposeful feedback that will move learning forward in all areas of writing **across the curriculum**.

The ensure handwriting is marked immediately and incorrect spellings are corrected by children in all lessons involving writing. More rigorous approach to the teaching of handwriting is required.

To ensure spelling is taught through handwriting at least three times a week.

To ensure outdoor areas are developed for EYFS, year 1, year 2 and year 3, and used regularly so that there are daily reading and writing opportunities across the curriculum.

Develop opportunities for pupils in the EYFS to achieve greater depth.

Leadership and Management (Intent and Impact)

To ensure that teaching and its impact on learning is **solidly good** and **rapidly improving towards becoming outstanding** continuing the focus on deeper questioning and challenge.

To **rapidly** improve the achievement of all pupils in reading and maths in KS2 ensuring better progress is made.

To increase the number of pupils working at greater depth in writing.

To provide effective team teaching opportunities within the alliance, to allow staff to peer mentor and work closely with other leaders and teachers.

Develop full awareness of the curriculum
