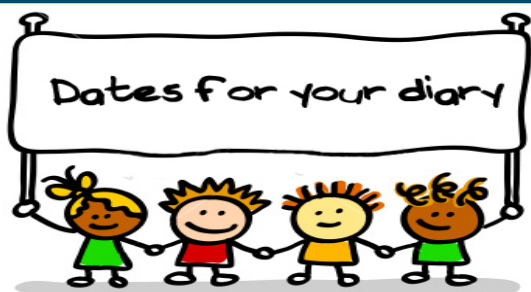

North Yorkshire Police run an event called the 'LIFESTYLE CHALLENGE 2019'.

The winners of the challenge last year, won an activity holiday at Bewerley Park where they spent a week canoeing, mountain biking, zip-wiring and orienteering. This prize was also awarded at a presentation ceremony at York Race-course. There is a lot of emphasis based on this challenge from north Yorkshire Police and a lot of support is given from the local policing team and the local PCSO's are all more than happy to meet teams and offer what support we can.
