BUZZ CLUB: Wrap-around care service

The Breakfast and After-School club (the 'Buzz Club'), is a fantastic facility that we are very lucky to be able to offer.

If you would like your child/children to attend, it is quick and simple. You can email the office: admin@leavening.n-yorks.sch.uk to book them in.

Payment is made via ParentPay. An admission form will need completing initially.



Breakfast Club runs everyday in term time from 7.45am until 8.45am. For £3 per day, you can drop your child at school early morning, where they can enjoy a delicious breakfast.

After school provision is split into 2 sessions: 3.15 - 4.15pm (£3.00 per session) and 4.15 - 5.45pm (£5.00 per session) with a healthy snack served at 4.30pm. This runs everyday apart from Thursdays.
