Spellings

Home Learning

In order to compliment your child's education it is extremely important for them to carry out home learning activities for approximately fifteen minutes each day. These activities include reading, practising spellings and times tables.

At the end of year 4, children should be able to instantly recall facts for ALL the times tables.

We would recommend little and often (five minutes per activity). Thank you for your support.

Please check your child's home learning journal for the topic home learning grid and the reading grid that contains recommended books (linked to the topic) and fun activities to complete during reading.

Friendly Reminder

Please make sure that reading books, reading record books, spelling books and home learning journals are brought into school each day.

Please make sure PE kits stay in school. PE is a compulsory part of the curriculum that requires appropriate kit. This includes: navy blue or black jogging bottoms AND shorts; a black or navy hooded top or sweatshirt; a white t-shirt and black or dark trainers. This is part of our school uniform policy.
