LEAVENING COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL - REMOTE EDUCATION PLAN

This Plan outlines our new updated Remote Education curriculum, to be implemented from Wednesday 6th January in the light of the national COVID-19 lockdown and school closures. This Plan is based on the most recent Government guidance to schools regarding remote education expectations. Government guidance for remote learning for primary children is a minimum of 3 hours a day, on average.

At Leavening, **Reception, KS1** and **KS2** children are expected to complete a <u>minimum of three daily lessons</u> linked to Core and Foundation subjects, with additional reading and topic tasks.

The class teacher will communicate with all pupils in the class by 9.00am daily **via email**, and via Zoom, regarding lessons for the day. This will be linked to the weekly planning in place for the class.

Oak Trees Class and Conkers Class

For Oak Trees class, there will be a daily Zoom registration session at <u>9.00am</u> with Mrs Price. <u>All children are expected to access this session</u>. During this session, Mrs Price will explain to children and parents about the specific lessons for the day and how to access them.

For Conkers class, there will be a daily Zoom registration session at <u>9.30am</u> with the class teacher. <u>All children</u> <u>are expected to access this session</u>. During this session, the teacher will explain to children and parents about the specific lessons for the day and how to access them.

- **Daily Maths lesson for Reception Y6**. This will be a combination of White Rose Maths videos (the scheme used in school), Oak National Academy and follow up activities to complete.
- **Daily English lesson for Reception Y6** via Oak National Academy, following the sequence of learning planned for the half term.
- Daily Phonics lessons for Reception and KS1 via PowerPoint/ video.
- Daily Foundation subject lessons (Art, History, Science, RE, Computing, Music and French) for Y3 Y6 via Oak National Academy/ PurpleMash/ other resources, following the sequence of learning planned for the half term. There will be at least one daily lesson for each child to follow and complete.
- Reading and Homework tasks children will be expected to complete reading and homework tasks
 outlined in the grids sent home at the start of the half-term. We expect children to work on one activity
 from these grids per day.
- Children are expected to read at home for a minimum of 15 minutes per day.
- All children in Conkers and Oak Trees will also receive a **weekly 1-to-1 reading session with a Teaching Assistant via Zoom** (from 11.1.21 onwards). Individual emails will be sent regarding times/ dates.
- Children will receive weekly spellings to learn and practise at home (issued on Mondays). For Oak Trees class, this will be by PowerPoint/ video with follow-up activities.
- Children are expected to submit work by email/ photos etc to the class teacher daily. One piece of work will be marked daily per child.
- Dojo Points and certificates will be awarded weekly.
- Oak Trees class will also have a weekly 'social' zoom session to help them keep in touch with their class –
 details to follow.
- If Staff have concerns over lack of engagement with remote learning or any safeguarding concerns, we will contact families/ pupils by telephone to check on progress and wellbeing. Staff will expect to speak to pupils directly during this call.
- **1:1 support** if your child receives 1:1 support and is not in school, a more bespoke programme of support will be offered. This may include phone calls / video chats with your child's 1:1 support.

At the end of each day, there will be a story time and catch up session with the class teacher via Zoom. This will give children the chance to ask questions about their learning, to prepare for the following day.

For Oak Trees class, this will take place at 2.30pm daily. For Conkers class, this will take place at 3.00pm daily.

Acorns Nursery

For Acorns children, activities and teacher videos will be posted daily on Tapestry (on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays) at 9.30am.

- There will be a weekly 'live' **Zoom group chat and story time** with Miss Cooke on Mondays time to be confirmed.
- Nursery children not accessing the critical worker provision will receive a weekly 1-1 Zoom 'chat and check-in' with Miss Cooke on Fridays (from 15th January). Individual emails will be sent regarding times.

Further changes may be made to this plan over the coming weeks. Any changes will be communicated to parents. If parents are having difficulties accessing online learning, please contact school immediately.

Please note that for safeguarding purposes, all Zoom sessions will be recorded by staff. If you are unable to attend/ access a session, please let us know and we will send you the link to the session. If you have any queries regarding this matter, please contact the Headteacher.
