As the COVID-19 situation continues, a reminder that staff, children or parents experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (new and persistent cough or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell) must NOT come to school, should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should arrange to have a test to see if they have coronavirus (COVID-19).

We can provide a test if you have difficulty in accessing one.

If we send your child home from school with Covid-19 symptoms, they will need to be free of the symptoms and have a negative test before returning to school.

In the event of one member of a household experiencing symptoms, the whole household would need to self-isolate. Please see the school website for details of our remote learning plan, should a child or family need to self-isolate.
