It is inevitable that in the coming weeks and months we will have to deal with the impact of COVID-19.

As a reminder, staff, children or parents experiencing COVID-19 symptoms:

> new and persistent cough

> or a high temperature,

>or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell) **must NOT come to school**, should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should arrange to have a test to see if they have coronavirus (COVID-19).

If we send your child home from school with Covid-19 symptoms, <u>they will need to be free of the symptoms AND have a</u> <u>negative test</u> before returning to school. In the event of one member of a household experiencing symptoms, the whole household would need to self-isolate. Where a child or family needs to self-isolate, we will provide suitable home learning for children to complete when they are well enough to do so.

If your child is absent from school for any reason, please let us know on the morning of the first day of absence by 9.30am. If a child is absent and we have not been given any reason for this absence, we will attempt to contact you.

We are getting used to the new drop off and pick up arrangements and I would like to thank parents for supporting us with this and keeping socially distanced at the school gates in the morning and afternoon. You will have received a letter from Mrs Kemp regarding who has permission to pick children up from school. If you have not already done so, please return this to school as possible so that we can ensure we are keeping children safe.

Normally, at this point in the term we would be giving you information about lots of upcoming events and dates for your diary. Sadly, it looks as though most of the usual school events will not be able to take place this term. Parents Evenings in particular are a vital part of our relationship between school and home. At this stage, it is unlikely that we can offer appointments on the school site so we will be looking at other ways of updating you about your child's progress.

Despite all of the challenges currently being presented, the school feels very positive and the staff and I are greatly looking forward to the coming term. As the Leavening school motto says, "Together we can!"
