Our School Improvement Priorities for 2021-22

I would like to share with you a summary of our school improvement action plan for this year. We are already making good strides towards these and look forward to keeping you informed of the impact of them over the year.

- Continue with our personal and bespoke (4-year cycle) curriculum design ensuring learning experiences are meaningful, purposeful, and progressive so that our pupils build on prior knowledge and 'know more and remember more'
- Further develop opportunities for pupils to fully engage in a love for reading.
- Ensure approaches to teaching reading are consistent across the whole school
- Ensure that the Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage One pupils have access to a well-planned, engaging, and rich play-based curriculum. Major improvements to the indoor and outdoor classrooms are in place.
