#### **Competition time- Sensory Garden Summer 2022**

We have an exciting opportunity coming our way in 2022. We have been awarded a grant under the Healthy School Scheme to make our dream of having our own sensory garden, become a reality. In the spring we will start our process of creating this garden for all our pupils to enjoy. It will support all the great things we do at Leavening to promote emotional and mental health and well-being. We are asking our pupils to design this garden and will use ideas from the most thoughtful and inspiring designs.

Please could you encourage your child to design a sensory garden for a space approximately 6 metres by 2 metres (6 x 2 m) and to include features, surfaces, objects, and plants that stimulate our senses through touch, sight, scent, taste and hearing.

#### Hello from the Governors

Each month we will introduce you to one of our members of the governing body here at Leavening and also use this opportunity to inform you of some of the work in which they do. This week we are delighted to hear from our Local Authority Governor - Dr. Sandra Whitson.



Sandra was appointed as a Local Authority Governor in 2021.

"We moved to North Yorkshire from West Yorkshire about eighteen months ago and I joined the Governing Body in January 2021 as the Local Authority Governor. I am, therefore, very new to the school and the community.

My whole professional life has been committed to education, my teaching career having ranged across kindergarten, primary, secondary, university and further education in Britain, Europe and the USA with a corresponding experience of governance. Since my retirement I have kept my interest in education vibrant in a variety of governance appointments.

Having been a National Leader of Governance from 2016-21 I am keen to contribute to Leavening's Governing Body as appropriate. For example, I am at present the Governor with responsibility for monitoring English and on my two visits this term I observed the school's approach to the teaching of reading and listened to children reading. In June I attended a staff training day when I met with the Head Teacher and staff who gave me a very warm welcome.

I have been impressed with the friendly environment of the school, the interesting and relevant displays in the classrooms and the courteous friendly children who are a credit to the staff and to the community."
