### A Lifetime Tale

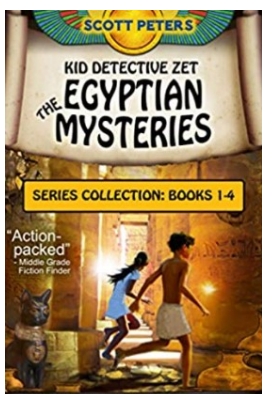
Draw your main character from your book.
