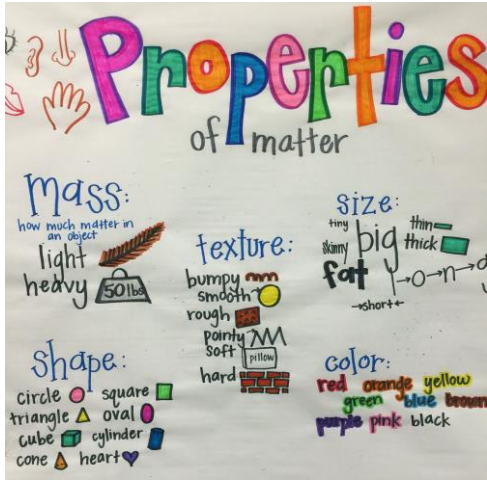


Conkers Class (KS1)

Is There Anyone Out There?

Use your Science Knowledge Organiser to support you with learning activities:

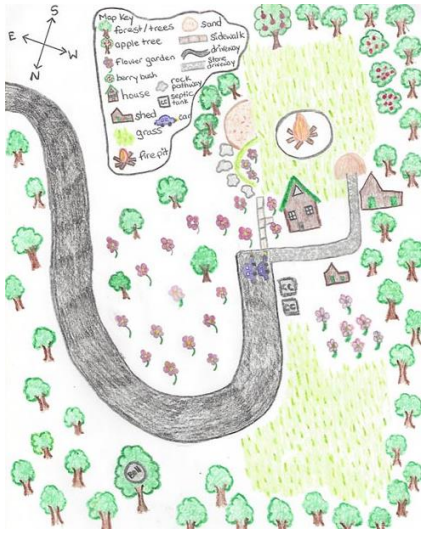
1) Collect various items from around your house and sort them into groups based on what they're made from e.g. wood, plastic, glass, metal, cardboard and fabric.



2) Sort various items from around your house into groups based on their properties e.g. strong, lightweight/heavy, flexible/stiff and describe them.

Use your Geography Knowledge Organiser to support you with learning activities:

1) Draw a simple map of an area. It could be where you live or a totally made up area. Label the features such as other houses, post office, school, doctors, pub and car park. Remember to create a key!



2) Think about how you travel to school. Use a smartphone, tablet or Ipad to record your journey to school.

You could record parts or all of your journey and talk about interesting places/things you pass on the way.

Carry out one of the following 'Understanding the World' activities:

- 1) Think about how you travel to school. Use a smartphone, tablet or Ipad to record your journey to school.

- 2) Draw a picture of your house and the buildings/other objects you can see near it. Label everything in your picture.



- 3) Collect various small items at home from inside and outside your house such as twigs, stones, leaves, conkers, pine cones, glass, bowl, metal tin, plastic bottle and sort them into groups of your choice. You could choose:

- Natural and man-made materials,
- Soft and hard materials
- Wooden, plastic and metal materials
