Online Safety for our pupils at Leavening

Dear parents/carers

We recently carried out a pupil survey and pupil voice around online safety in KS2. We would like to share some of the outcomes of this as we feel it is key information for you.

Positives

- Our pupils know what counts as personal information and that this shouldn't be posted or written about online.
- They know what to do if something or someone makes them feel uncomfortable on line.
- The vast majority of our pupils say that they have the same friends online and offline
 which indicates they do not chat with strangers. However some state that they do
 have friends online that they have never met.
- Our pupils are always keen to learn more about online safety.

Areas of interest for parents/carers

- 80% of pupils were unsure whether their devices at home have privacy settings on.
- 75% of pupils said they do not talk with adults at home about safe rules for internet browsing.
- 70% of our pupils spend over 2 hours each day online.
- A number of our Y5/6 pupils say they access social media.

What can you do to support your child's knowledge and safety online?
