Curriculum coverage for this half term

the following list outlines the area of the curriculum we will be studying for each subject. KO indicates that there is a knowledge organiser for this topic, where you can find additional details about the key information the children will be learning:

Maths: Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions... and more!

English:

In English we will be writing riddle poetry!

Geography:

As geographers we will be exploring our topic of 'Exploring Eastern Europe' were we will be 'flying' around the world to compare the differences and similarities between the UK and different Eastern European countries. We will be practising and improving our knowledge of continents, countries and cities and working towards writing holiday brochures encouraging people to take a trip to a different country!

Science:

In science we will be learning all about electricity, circuits and how it is used! . Our working scientifically focus is plan and we will be working of comparative and fair testing.

Our computing topic this term will first recap our online safety skills as a class. Year 3 and 4 will then focus on their topic 'Audio production' and year 5 and 6 will be focusing on 'Web page creation'.

Personal, Social, Health Education

In Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE) we will be learning about 'Celebrating Differences'.

Years 3 and 4 Children will explore:

- Recognising how words can be hurtful
- Giving and receiving compliments

Picture news

Each week we will learn about the British Values of:

Mutual respect and tolerance Individual liberty democracy Rule of law

Through exploring the weekly news and learning about relevant local, national and international issues. This is our 'Picture News' curriculum.

Years 5 and 6 Children will explore:

- Cultural differences and how they can cause conflict
- Racism Rumours and name-calling
- Types of bullying
- Material wealth and happiness
- Enjoying and respecting other cultures

Art and Design

In Art and Design we will be exploring the artist Pablo Picasso and looking at his inspiration for art. We will produce our own self portraits in the style of Picasso exploring tones, texture and colour shading through the medium of paint.

In PE we will be doing gymnastics where the children will be learning the skills of forward and side rolls, vaults and linking movements to perform a sequence.

We will also be learning dance linked to our Science topic of 'Electricity', again performing a sequence of moves based on free style and contemporary dance.

Religious Education (RE)

Year 3 and 4 will be learning about Christian beliefs and the teachings of Jesus and Year 5 and 6 will be learning about the Humanist approach to religion.

Music:

French:

As French linguists we will be securing our knowledge of family members, the French alphabet, months and colours.
