Les animaux



- Adjectives in French change depending on the **gender** and **number** of the noun that they describe.
- This means that they can have a **masculine** **feminine** and/or **plural** spelling.
- The general rule for how adjectives change is explained in the table below.

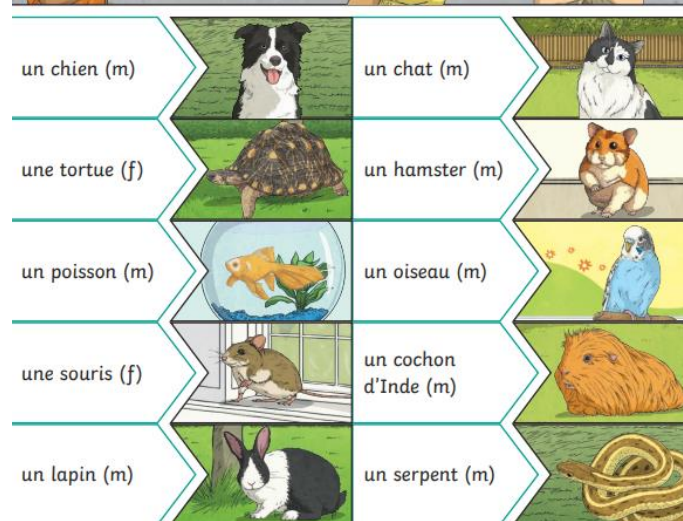
	Masculine	Feminine
Singular	grand	grande
Plural	grand s	grand es

To understand an adjective in a French sentence is positioned **after the noun**.

These adjectives **break** the rule:

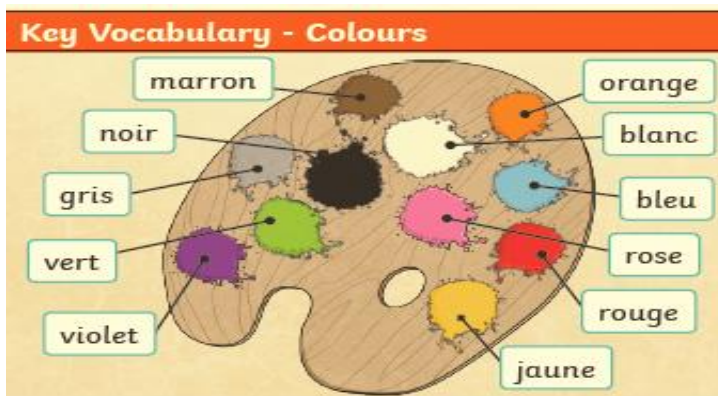
gross, bon, grand/long, joli, petit
