



<u>Adjectives in French change</u> depending on the <u>gender</u> and <u>number</u> of the noun that they describe.

 This means that they can have a <u>masculine</u> <u>feminine</u> and/or <u>plural</u> spelling.

The general rule for how adjectives change is explained in the table below.

	Masculine	Feminine
Singular	grand	grand <u>e</u>
Plural	grand <u>s</u>	grand <u>es</u>





To understand an adjective in a French sentence is positioned after the noun.


These adjectives break the rule:

gross, bon, grand/long, joli, petit

J'ai vu - I saw


Ils étaient – they were
