Short; Repetitive; Commanding; Dramatic; Bold; Loud (forte); Gets louder (cresecendo)





What is a fanfare?

A short piece of music played to announce something or someone important.

Often played on brass instruments.

Short, loud and repetitive.





4 beats 2 beats 1 beat $\frac{1}{2}$ beats

Pentatonic - 5 note scale often used in folk music

Ostinato - constantly repeating pattern. Can be a short melody pattern or a short rhythm pattern.
