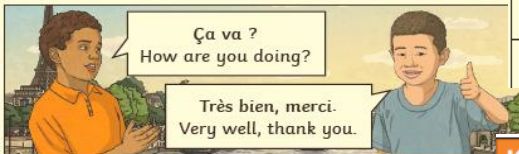

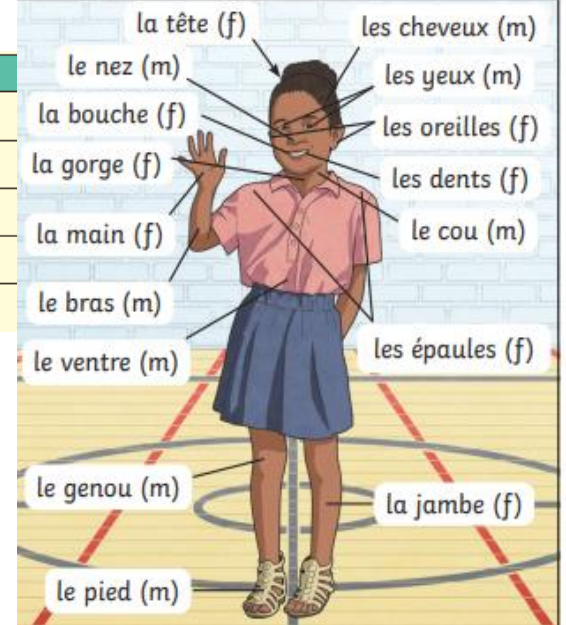

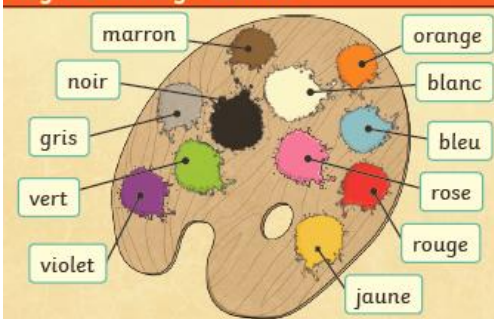

Key Vocabulary - Colours



- **Adjectives in French change** depending on the **gender** and **number** of the noun that they describe.
- This means that they can have a **masculine**, **feminine** and/or **plural** spelling.
- The general rule for how adjectives change is explained in the table below.
