Plural	grands	grandes

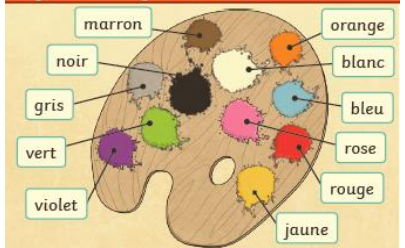
Key Vocabulary - What Do I Look Like?
