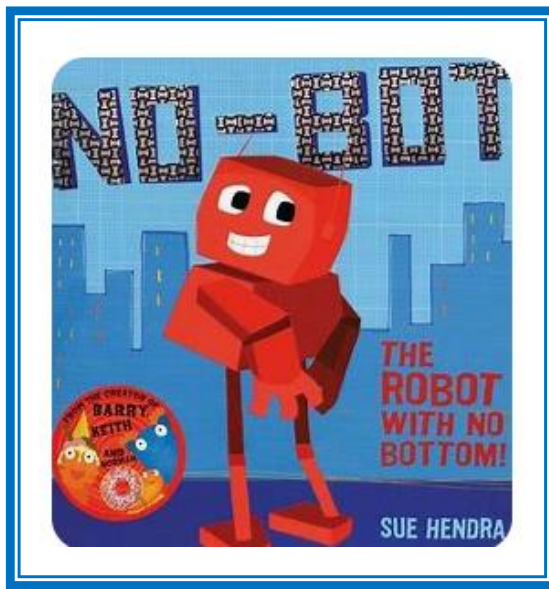
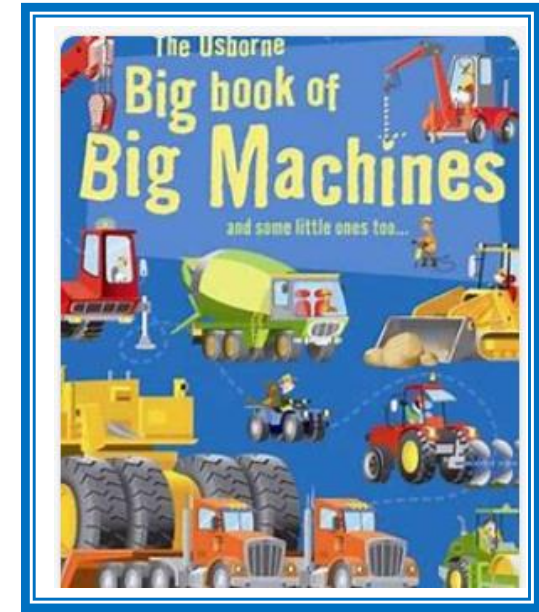

present tense verbs	Stripes The tiger has stripes on its coat to camouflage it amongst the trees so it can hunt without being seen.
third person pronouns	Cubs A baby tiger is called a cub. When it is eight months old, it joins its mother and goes hunting.
