- A packed lunch if your child is not having a school lunch. Every
 morning we take the lunch register. Please ensure that your
 child knows if they are having a hot lunch or a pack up. Menus
 are sent home for your reference every half term. You may
 wish to discuss your child's meal preference with them before
 they come to school.
