Expedition - is a special trip or journey that people make to explore or discover new places. It often involves going somewhere exciting or difficult

Explorer - a person who travels to new or unknown places to discover and learn about them

Antarctica - a very cold and snowy continent at the bottom of the Earth, around the South Pole. It's covered in ice and is the coldest place in the world, where penguins live and very few people visit because it's so cold!

Icebound - means something is stuck or trapped in ice and can't move

Survival - staying alive and safe, especially in difficult or dangerous situations

Tenzing Norgay - a famous mountain climber from Nepal who is best known for being one of the first people to reach the top of Mount Everest in 1953

Mount Everest - is the tallest mountain in the world. It is located in the Himalayas, between Nepal and China. The mountain is covered in snow and ice, and it can be very cold and windy at the top.

Summit - the very top of a mountain

Sherpa - a person from a group of people who live in the mountains of Nepal, especially in the Himalayas. Sherpas are known for their amazing climbing skills and are often guides for people who want to climb tall mountains like Mount Everest. They help climbers by carrying supplies, showing the way, and sharing their knowledge about the mountains. Sherpas are very strong and brave, and they play a big role in mountain climbing adventures

Prayer Flag - a colourful piece of cloth that people hang outside, usually in the mountains of Nepal and Tibet. These flags have special symbols and words printed on them that represent good wishes, blessings, and prayers
