

Land Ahoy



- A sea shanty is a type of work song sung by sailors at sea.
- There are records of sailors singing sea shanties since 1869.
- Sea shanties feature Call and response.
- The 'caller' is called the Shantyman they would often improvise the words to songs.
- Sea shanties have a strong steady beat.
- The rhythm of the song helped the sailors to work together.
 Work was really hard. It included loading, pulling, pumping, dropping and raising the anchor and setting the sails.
- There are 3 types of shanty: Short-Haul shanties, Halyard shanties and Windlass shanties each for different types of job.
- The lyrics often rhymed to help remember them.
- Sea shanties were usually unaccompanied.
- Singing also helped to alleviate boredom. Sailors were often at sea for a very long time and missed home.
- The word shanty comes from the French word 'chanter' meaning 'to sing'.
- Sea shanties make references to shipboard practices and help to tell us about history at sea. Sometimes the language can be rather rude...

Synopsis:

How to play a triad ...

Play a note, miss a note, play a note, miss, play.

Major triads (sound 'happy')



C major = C E G

Minor triads (sound 'sad') A minor = A C E D minor = D F A

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
