

### Key Vocabulary

**Christianity** - a religion that teaches about the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, who Christians believe is the Son of God

**Bible** – a special book that Christians believe is God’s word

**God**- in Christianity, God is the Creator of everything!

Christians believe God made the world, the sky, the animals, and even us!

**Jesus** - Christians believe that Jesus is the Son of God. He came to Earth a long time ago to teach people about God’s love and how to live in kindness and peace.

**Old Testament** – the first part of the Bible. It is a big collection of stories and teachings that show how God created the world and helped people long ago.

**New Testament** – the second part of the Bible. It is about Jesus, His life, His teachings, and how His followers spread His message of love and forgiveness.

**Lord’s Prayer** – a special prayer that Jesus taught his followers

**Ten Commandments** - special rules from God that help us know how to love Him and treat other people kindly

**Disciples** – twelve special friends of Jesus who travelled with Jesus, listened to His teachings, and helped Him teach others.

**Worship** - to show love, honour, and respect to God

### How Do Christians Show Their Faith?

#### **Worship:**

honouring and giving thanks to God.

Sharing the message: spreading the message of God’s love.

Putting Jesus’ teachings into action: showing kindness and love to others.



### Who is God?

Christians believe that God is the creator of the universe, including the heavens and the Earth. They believe that God is all - powerful and forgiving. He sent Jesus Christ, His son, to teach us about God’s love and his forgiveness.
