## **Phonics**

Please look out for some phonics information coming home with your child. These guides will explain what your child will learn in the coming term. Please take time to read and digest this information, as any support that you can provide at home will be hugely beneficial to your child. Whilst it is the school's role to teach reading, parents/carers do also play a vital role. It is important that your child receives plenty of practice reading at home to become a fluent, confident reader. At least 3 times per week, try to read with your child. During these reads, your child should be able to read the practice book with developing confidence and fluency, without any significant help. The parent/carer's role is to listen with interest and, most importantly, to encourage and praise, enthusiastically acknowledging the child's achievement. After your child has read the book, it may be helpful to talk about the text, but only so far as your child is interested. The parent/carer should keep the experience positive and avoid turning it into a test. We really want our children to become lifelong readers, so please also enjoy together the library book your child brings home. This is a book for you to read to or with your child - the goal is enjoyment and reading for pleasure! Many thanks for all your continued support on our reading journey!
