### Who are you?

What makes you you? Bring an item/picture that represents something about you. Write about how this represents you!

### Roman Shield

Design a roman shield that represents you! Research and take inspiration from real Roman attire!

### Roman rumble!

Research, draw and label some Roman musical instruments! Are they similar to any we have? What did they sound like! (if you are feeling creative feel free to build/make one)

### Changes!

Sit down on a chair calmly for 2 minutes - what do you notice about your body/heart rate/ breathing. Now do something active! Record/write down/draw the changes that happen. Feel free to send in films/pictures

### PSHE

What career or job inspires you? Can you research this job and use the information you have found to make a poster or presentation about it. Can you map out the education pathway you need to take to be able to achieve success in this job? What skills and experience can you start getting now to help you for the future?
