Select from the following learning activities (these are optional - only if your child wishes to! The main 'learning at home' activity that we recommend is reading at home with your child three times per week - when they bring their first reading book home! Thankyou!)

- Can you use recycled materials (like cereal boxes, bottle caps, and toilet rolls) to make a robot or machine? Take a picture and bring it to school.
- Can you draw or build a model of a futuristic vehicle (e.g., a flying car, hoverboard, or submarine train). Describe how it works.
- Have a think about what people will eat in the future. Draw or describe a futuristic meal. Will it be colourful? Will it grow on trees or in the ground? Maybe it's in a tablet!
- Use blocks, Lego, or other toys to build a model of what a city might look like in the future. Take a photo and share it!
