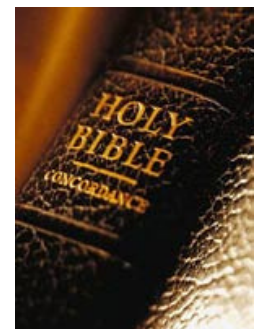
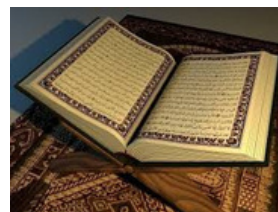

The Torah is written in Hebrew and includes laws, stories, and teachings that guide the lives of Jewish people. Guru Granth Sahib contains hymns and writings from Sikh Gurus and other saints. It emphasises equality, community service, and devotion to God. All faiths treat their sacred books with care and respect.

1. The Bible has over 66 different books.
2. The Qu'ran has 114 chapters known as Surahs.
3. The Torah is also known as the Pentateuch (five books).
4. Sikhs celebrate the Guru Granth Sahib during special ceremonies called Gurdwaras.
5. The Bible was originally written in Hebrew, Greek, and Aramaic.
6. The Qu'ran was revealed to Muhammad over 23 years.
7. Many Jewish holidays are based on stories from the Torah.
8. The Guru Granth Sahib contains scriptures from different authors, showing unity among diverse beliefs.
