KEY GRAMMAR FACTS

Linking words are used to give more than one piece of information in a sentence :

et = and

mais = but

parce que = because

e.g. *J'aime jouer au foot parce que c'est passionnant, mais je déteste faire du vélo parce que c'est fatigant.*

We use the verbs *jouer* (to play) for some sports and *faire* (to do) for others. Can you think why?

The Near Future :

The near future **tense** (le futur proche) is used to express something that will be happening in the very near future. It is formed by conjugating the verb **aller** (to go) in the present tense, followed by an infinitive.

English	To go (present)	Infinitive
I am going to go	Je vais	aller
I am going to play	Je vais	jouer
I am going to watch	Je vais	regarder
