Enhancing Maths Learning

Goal: Boost confidence and achievement in maths, especially in problem-solving.

What's Happening:

- **Vocabulary** Focus: Introducing a whole-school maths vocabulary framework to help children understand and use mathematical terms effectively.
- **Interactive Learning**: Implementing 'Plan a Think Aloud' strategies to encourage children to verbalize their problem-solving processes.

How It Helps Your Child: These strategies aim to make maths more accessible and enjoyable, fostering a deeper understanding and confidence in problem-solving.

Improving Presentation Across the Curriculum

Goal: Ensure consistent and high-quality presentation in all subjects.

What's Happening:

- Policy Updates: Revising handwriting and presentation policies to set clear expectations.
- **Staff Training**: Providing training sessions for teachers to maintain consistency.
- Student Involvement: Encouraging peer and self-assessment to promote ownership of work quality.
- **Celebrations**: Showcasing exemplary work through displays and rewards.

How It Helps Your Child: A consistent approach to presentation enhances pride in work and reinforces attention to detail.

Creating Calm and Tidy Learning Environments

- Parental Involvement: Regular communication with parents about their child's progress.
- Curriculum Integration: Updating PSHE and pastoral curricula to address identified needs.

- Events: Introducing 'Wellbeing Wednesdays' and reward schemes to promote positivity.
- Workshops: Offering sessions for parents to support their children's wellbeing at home.

How It Helps Your Child: A focus on wellbeing ensures a supportive environment that encourages regular attendance and emotional resilience.

Y Strengthening Early Years Provision

Goal: Enhance early language, writing, and developmental outcomes.
