May Day has two names in French: la fête du muguet (Lily of the Valley Day) and la fête du travail (International Workers' Day or Labour Day).

Bastille Day is celebrated in France on 14th July (le quatorze juillet).

It is also known as la fête nationale

World Music Day (la fête de la musique) was first celebrated in 1982. It takes place every year on 21st June (le vingt-et-un juin), which is the longest day of the year, or Summer Solstice.

For many people in France, 6th December (le six décembre) marks St. Nicholas' Day (la fête de Saint-Nicolas).

Christmas celebrations in France last until 6th January (le six janvier ), when the arrival of the Three Kings (les Rois mages) is celebrated. This is called Epiphany (l'Épiphanie) or la fête des Rois




