Rhythm is a pattern of long and short notes, while pulse is a regular underlying beat.

Sixteenth note	Semiquaver		1/4 of a beat

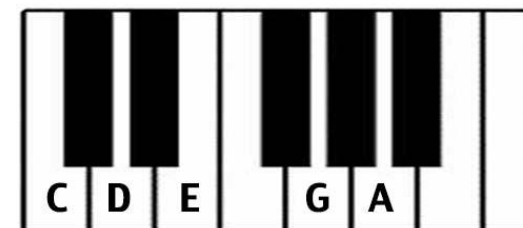
