“You Said – We Will”

At Leavening Community Primary School, keeping safe and feeling safe is really important. Here’s what you told us and what we will do to make things even better:

 You Said: Some pupils only feel safe sometimes, and a few places in school don’t always feel safe (hall, toilets, shed, Forest School, trips).


☒ We Will: Check these areas, add extra supervision where needed, and make sure everyone knows how we keep them safe.

 You Said: A few pupils are worried about learning struggles, work being too hard, or when it gets noisy.

☒ We Will: Give extra support with learning, provide quiet spaces, and help with strategies to manage noise.

 You Said: Some pupils aren’t sure about the difference between safe and unsafe secrets.

☒ We Will: Do more lessons and activities to remind everyone about safe and unsafe secrets.

 You Said: A small number of children would ignore or share something worrying online instead of telling an adult.

☒ We Will: Keep teaching online safety and practise what to do if something pops up online.

 You Said: Some pupils felt their worries aren’t always taken seriously.

☒ We Will: Show pupils how we act on their worries with ‘you said – we did’ boards and regular check-ins.
