Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to the majority of families who consistently support our current school policy on jewellery. Most children come to school without earrings or other personal effects, and this really helps us maintain fairness, consistency, and—most importantly—safety.

We would like to remind all families that under no circumstances should earrings or jewellery be worn to school. Personal items such as earrings, rings and necklaces present a risk of injury to the wearer and to others, particularly during PE, Forest Schools, playtimes, and other physical activities. There have been serious incidents nationally involving jewellery in PE, and this guidance exists to protect everyone.

When some children continue to wear earrings, it becomes difficult to instil a sense of fairness and consistency across the school. We kindly ask all families to respect and adhere to this uniform policy.

Please be aware that children who wear earrings to school will not be able to take part in physical activities, including PE and Forest Schools, due to the safety risks.
