Key Vocabulary

Fair	Treating everyone kindly and equally.
Safe	Being protected from danger or harm.
Creation	Everything in the world that God made.
Nature	Plants, animals, and the natural world around us.
Khalifah	An Arabic word meaning a person who looks after the Earth for Allah.
Caretaker	Someone who looks after and protects people, animals, or places.
Tzedakah	A Jewish way of helping others by giving to people in need.
Protect	To keep something safe from harm.
Golden Rule	Treat other people the way you would like to be treated.
Neighbour	Someone who lives near you or anyone you can help and care for.
Care	Looking after someone or something kindly.
Kindness	Being friendly, helpful, and caring towards others.
Respect	Treating people, animals, and the world in a thoughtful and kind way.
Charity	Giving money, time, or help to people who need it.
Responsibility	A job or duty to help look after something or someone.
Environment	The world around us, including plants, animals, air, land, and water.
Samaritan	A person who helps others, especially someone in need. This comes from the story of the Good Samaritan.
Earth	The planet where we live.

Core Knowledge

- Know that caring for others and the world means being kind, helpful, and respectful to other people and looking after the Earth, including animals, plants, and the environment.
- This also includes making the world a better, fairer, and safer place for everyone

Christian Beliefs:

- God made the world, so it is important to look after it.
- Jesus taught people to “love your neighbour” and help those in need.
- Know a Bible story about caring for other and the world such as ‘Jesus feeds the 5,000’, ‘Noah’s Ark’ or the ‘Creation story’
- Christians try to follow Jesus’ example by being kind, giving to others, and protecting nature

Muslim Beliefs:

- Muslims believe Allah (God) created everything, so the world must be respected.
- People are caretakers (khalifahs) of the Earth.
- Being kind, helping others, and giving to charity (Zakah) are important.
- Muslims are taught to treat animals gently, avoid waste, and care for the planet
- Know a story from the Qur’an about caring for others and the world such as ‘The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and the Camel’, ‘The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) and the Orphan’ or ‘The Prophet’s Teaching About Water’

Jewish Beliefs:

- Jewish people believe God made the world and gave humans the job of looking after it.
- They are taught to do Tzedakah (righteous giving) and show kindness and fairness.
- Caring for people, animals, and the Earth is a key part of living a good life
- Know a story from the Torah about looking after each other and the world, such as the Creation story and how God told humans to look after the Earth

Know that this matters because:

- Caring helps make people feel safe, valued, and happy.
- Looking after the world helps protect it for the future.
- People from different religions and backgrounds all believe it is important to be kind and caring.
